Year 3 home learning

- Continue daily reading either your school book or books at home

- Complete your homework and practise your spellings
- Continue to practise your handwriting

Additional activities could include:

Maths – We are currently learning about multiplication and division in maths (doubling and halving). These fast pace maths games can help with developing recalling multiplication and division knowledge quickly. https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/7-11-years/multiplication-and-division

Alternatively, you can use a pack of playing cards to play the Multiplication Snap Card Game, which children are familiar with. This can be adapted to be done with addition and subtraction.

English – Continue to develop an understanding of when and where we use punctuation within our writing. You could practice writing some sentences to show these. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zvwwxnb

We will also be writing letters to Mrs. Cole, you could research features of letter and practice writing letters to your friends or family.

Science – Within our science, we are currently learning about light. What can you find out about sunlight and how important it is? What items can you find that are reflectors of light? E.g sequins

Linking to our previous topic and food technology, think about the importance of healthy eating. Using a Eat Well Guide think of some food recipe ideas which meet the guidance on eating such as 5 pieces of fruit of vegetables a day. You can be as imaginative as you like!

Geography / Topic – Our World – Create a poster or leaflet on Our World topic. Think about using and defining continents, latitude, longitude, the equator, climate zones and time zones. What amazing facts about the world can you find out?

You could also use online maps to research our local area or somewhere in the world you are interested in. What features on the map can you identify e.g. rivers or mountains.

DT – We are going to be making a 3D castle, look at the different parts of a castle and plan the materials you could use to make these e.g. the towers of the castle could be made out of cardboard tubes from paper towels. You may want to try making one to see how effective different the materials you have chosen are.
