World Book Day vouchers

Please be reminded that if you or your child show any of the symptoms of COVID-19 – a high temperature (37.8 or more) or a new continuous cough or a change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia), you must not come into school and you must follow Government guidelines regarding testing and isolation. Testing is now available and anyone (staff and children) showing the signs or symptoms will be expected to be tested. You must inform us of the outcome of a test as soon as possible.

If your child is ill (not COVID-19 related) you should continue to follow school rules regarding this and keep them home for the permitted time. You must of course, notify the school of any absence.
