

How do I learn to write? How can I help at home?



Threading and lacing – buttons, Cheerios, pasta.

Playdough – rolling, stretching, cutlery.

Tweezers and tongs – pick up small objects.

Opening and closing everyday items – buttons, lids, containers.

Independent dressing – socks, shoes, coats, jumpers.

Finger rhymes – Incy Wincy Spider.

Construction – Lego, Duplo, etc.

How do I learn to do Maths? All children can do Maths but first need to...




How do I learn to do Maths?

How do I learn to read? How can I help at home?

Read to your child – imagination, prediction, how books work. Retelling favourite stories in your own words – sequencing. Environmental print – shop names, P (parking), street names. Nursery Rhymes – rhyming songs, games and stories. Tell stories about pictures – photos, waiting at the bus stop. Matching games – colours, shapes, socks... Be a reading model.
